- 1. The gift of prophecy is absolutely vital! In fact, we wouldn't have the Bible as we now know it if not for the spirit of prophecy. $(2 \text{ Timothy } 3:16, 17^1)$
- 2. God desires to keep us informed of His plans for us. He tells us through the prophet Amos that He will do nothing without first revealing it to His servants the prophets. (Amos 3:7³)
- 3. Because prophecy is a primary method of God's communication the Devil has raised up false prophets to confuse and distract from the truth. (Matthew 24:115; 7:156)
- 4. There are four tests of a true prophet: they will not contradict the Word of God; they will affirm that Jesus came as a man with our nature; they will keep the commandments demonstrating the character of God; and the prophecies they predict will come to pass. (see Tests of a Prophet p. 2)
- 5. The Bible has a consistent prophetic pattern. There's the one who makes the prophecy and at the time of the fulfillment God raises up another prophet who points people back to the author of the prophecy and its present fulfillment. (see Biblical Pattern of Prophets p. 2)
- 6. There are times God has a special message. Just as He sent John the Baptist to people who already had the Bible, He gave Ellen White the prophetic gift to give us more light. (Joel 2:28, 2915)
- 7. In keeping with God's sustained prophetic pattern, the Bible clearly teaches that the prophetic gift will again be active as we near His soon return. (Joel 2:28, 29¹⁵; Acts 2:17¹⁶)
